

Note: "Left Side" and "Right Side" of vehicle is from the perspective of sitting in the driver seat of the vehicle and looking forward

Installation

<u>Steps 1-5 Removal of factory exhaust and installation</u> of new exhaust

1. Remove the factory rear exhaust system:



2. Install the AAM Competition rear mid section (photo to the right). Slip the rear hanger rod into the factory rubber hanger at the front of the rear mid section. Use the supplied bolts, nuts and washers (two bolts and nuts per side, four washers per side) to attach the front of the rear mid section to the GT-R's midpipe. Leave this slightly loose for now.

3. Apply the two split rubber silicone hoses here (to keep from scratching the muffler):



- **4.** Install the AAM Competition muffler section. Slide the four hanger rods into the factory rubber hanger mounts:

- Use the supplied V-Band clamp to connect the rear mid section to the muffler section. Do not fully tighten yet.

- **6.** Slide the four suppled clamps onto the four tip pipes. Slide the four tips onto the tips pipes. Do not tighten yet.
- **7.** Adjust the exhaust for best fitment, and tighten both the two bolts at the front of the rear mid section and the V-Band clamp at the back of the rear mid section.
- **8.** Adjust the exhaust tips as desired, tighten the exhaust tip clamps to secure the exhaust tips to the exhaust.

9. Remove the upper trunk trim panel (remove the one luggage clip in the middle and two side pull pin fasteners):













10. Pull the side clips and remove the panel with the Velcro:







11. Remove the styrofoam section at the forward section of the trunk and cut it as follows:










12. Remove the rear trunk panel:







13. Pull back rear carpet on driver side to expose the grommet. Pull out the rubber gromet and cut a small slit in the rubber gromet:




14. Connect the antenna, vacuum line, and power cable to the vacuum generator as shown:













16. Remove the dome light clip and pull harness to expose power source.







17. Pull and remove harness through circular hole, to allow you to connect the power supply as shown:



18. Open the wire loom to expose the yellow power wire and utilize the included connector to connect the red and yellow wires as shown):











19. Use a fish wire (such as a coat hanger) to pull the wire back through the round hole to the rectangular style hole:



20. Install ground on stud as shown:







21. Tuck excess harness behind passenger side trunk trim:



22. Run vacuum line as shown, through the modified grommet and underneath the GT-R to the exhaust actuator:















- **23.** Run the vacuum line to the actuator can attached to the exhaust (driver side).
- **24.** Secure the vacuum line with tie wraps.

- 26. Before the interior panels are re-installed, test the electrical connections. Take the exhaust key fob and click on the "On" button. The vacuum generator should run for 2 to 3 seconds, and the actuator on the exhaust will move (opens the internal valve). After fifteen seconds, hit the "Off" button on the key fob, and the valve should return to its closed position. This means everything is installed correctly and functioning properly. If the pump continues to run (does not turn off after the "On" button is pressed after 2 to 5 seconds, this means that there may be an air leak, which needs to be fixed).
- **27.** Now that the system is verified to be wired and installed correctly, re-install all of the trunk paneling, styrofoam, and liner(s).
- **28.** Visually inspect installation of all components and ensure everything is reinstalled correctly and connected.
- 29. Start vehicle and verify that there are no exhaust leaks; If an exhaust leak is found, rectify the issue and repeat this step until no leaks are present
